czas past continuous służy do mówienia o:

- \* czynnościach, które <u>trwały</u> w określonym czasie w przeszłości (tzn. w określonym czasie w przeszłości byliśmy <u>w trakcie</u> ich wykonywania), np. **At 3 o'clock yesterday** afternoon Mike and his son **were washing** the dog. (Wczoraj o 3 po południu Mike i jego syn **myli** psa.)
- \* czynnościach tzw. długich, które trwały, a w czasie których nastąpiły inne, tzw. 'krótkie' czynności (te w past simple), np. While he **was reading** a newspaper, his wife **came back** home. (Kiedy on czytał gazetę, jego żona **wróciła** do domu.)
- \* czynnościach symultanicznych (takich, które **trwały w tym samym czasie**), np. The people **were watching** while the cowboy **was riding** the bull. (Ludzie **patrzyli**, jak kowboj **ujeżdżał** byka.)
- \* czynnościach, które były tłem w opowiadanej historii, np. Tom was driving his old truck through the forest. The sun was shining and the birds were singing. (Tom jechał starą ciężarówką przez las. Słońce świeciło, ptaki śpiewały.)

Operatorem czasu jest was/were, czasownik główny przyjmuje końcówkę -ing.
