ALREADY występuje w zdaniach twierdzących, między operatorem a czasownikiem głównym, np.

We've already been on four dates. - Byliśmy już na czterech randkach.

STILL występuje w zdaniach przeczących, przed operatorem, np.

I still haven't told her I've got a boyfriend. - Wciąż jej nie powiedziałam, że mam chłopaka.

YET występuje w zdaniach przeczących i pytających na końcu zdania, np.

Have you done your homework yet? - Czy już zrobiłaś zadanie domowe?

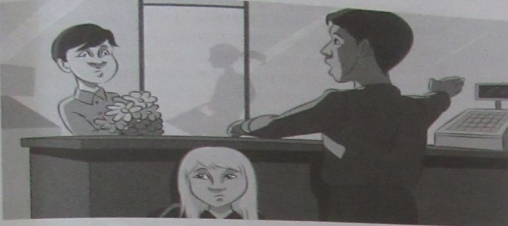
No, I haven't done it yet. - Nie, jeszcze go nie zrobiłam.
